IN A SENTENCE

Teams will propose innovative projects that transform vacant lots into assets that advance sustainability.

TIMING

November 2, 2012 – April 11, 2013
First-Round Submissions Dec. 10th

PROCESS

Assemble a team, select a vacant lot from six candidate sites, and propose your vision.

SUBMISSIONS

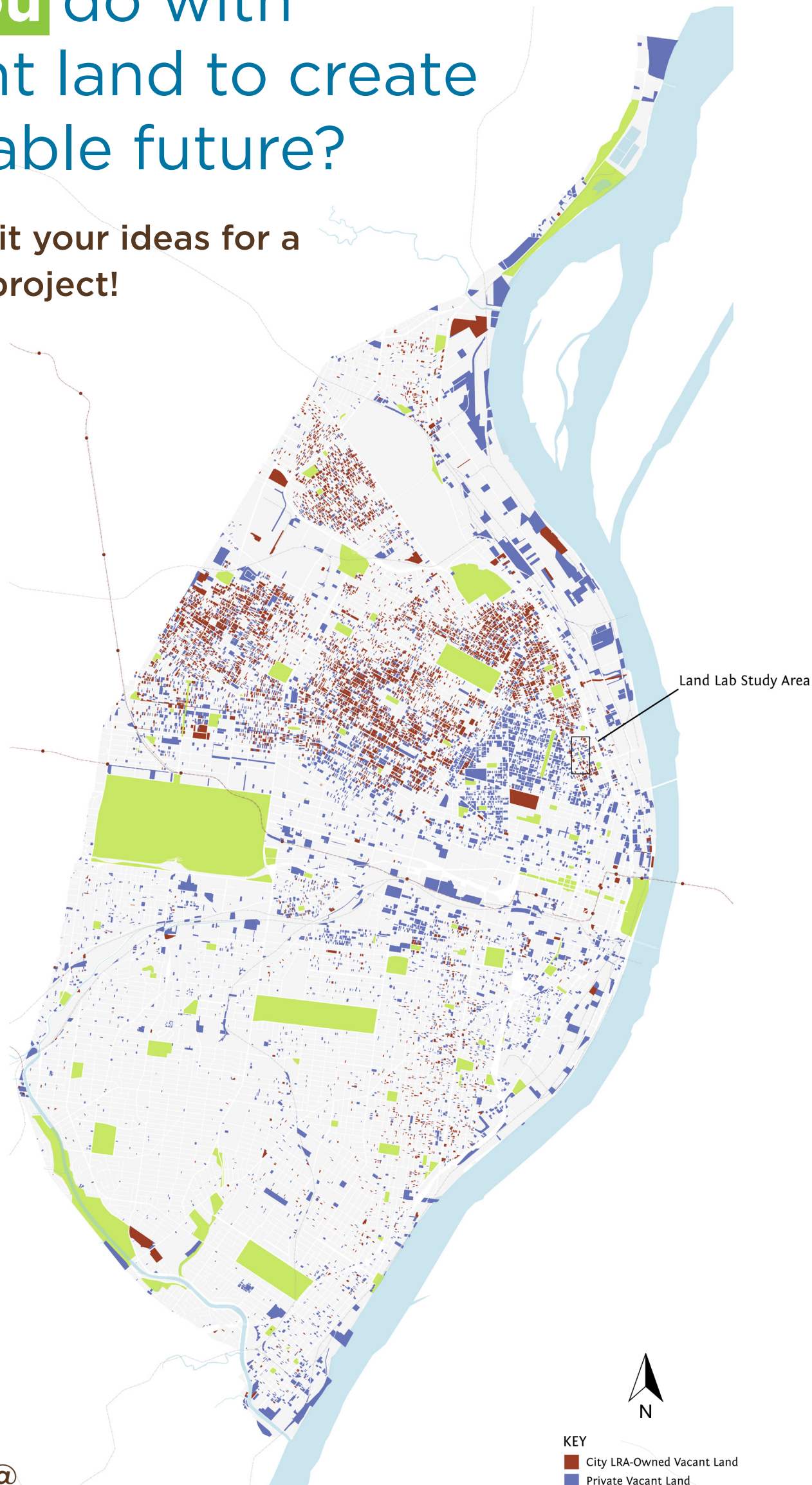
Three rounds of deliverables of increasing detail. First-round includes 2-page summary, optional image or video.

AWARDS

Two-year lease of a vacant lot and \$5,000 seed funding. Six project sites to choose from. Up to four awards will be granted.

IMPLEMENTATION

Winning teams will implement and maintain their projects as living laboratories, teaching tools, and regional sustainability assets for two years.
